

TOLL BRIDGE TOLERS PLANNING MEETING MINUTES

First Lutheran Church, Concord, CA
November 13, 2016

Present: Cathy McCaughey, Darlene Smith, Luci Flynn, Trish Bertolucci, Merlene Ryan, Karen Vecchi, Marianne Simpson, Jann Otvos, Barbara Bouchet

Cathy McCaughey called the meeting to order at 1:07 pm. She passed out a list of important dates for 2017 including

the January 21, 2017 giraffe class to be taught by Carolyn Silvas, a list of scheduled conventions throughout the year, and a list of other items to discuss at this meeting.

Cruise in November – Jann Otvos provided preliminary information she obtained from Cruise Adventures in Walnut Creek regarding a 3-day weekend cruise on Carnival to Catalina and Ensenada, Mexico or a 4-day cruise on Carnival or Princess Lines. She provided approximate costs (\$400 to \$600) and other fees charged. There is no fee for the travel agency. They would make the arrangements and include a flyer at no cost. Princess would depart from San Francisco (\$800 to \$1200) and go to Ensenada, Mexico via Santa Barbara and San Diego. A bus could be hired to transport participants from Concord to San Francisco for an additional fee. Mid November is the best time for Princess and reservations would be needed by February. Carnival makes the trip frequently. Jann will obtain more cost and sign-up information.

2017 Calendar – It was agreed to have three Saturday meetings in 2017 – March 18, May 20 and September 9. If a business meeting is needed it will be held the first 30 minutes. Cathy will contact Loretta Mateik about the BBQ in July. August 26 is the Bunco fundraiser and Liz Little will be contacted about renting the Plumbers' Hall in Martinez. The Christmas dinner will be held on December 19, location to be determined. The 2018 Planning Meeting will be held on November 12, 2017. We will continue to meet on the third Tuesday. Ideas for the location of the Christmas dinner were discussed. La Veranda in Clayton was discussed but parking is not good and it is expensive. Cathy will talk to Vivian Roubal who has suggestions for Martinez restaurants.

Ornament Exchanges – Will be held for Easter, Halloween and Christmas. Discussion followed on the items to be exchanged. It was agreed they are to be hand painted and small enough to fit in a lunch size brown paper bag.

Membership – Discussion followed regarding options for non-members attending meetings and classes. It was agreed a non-member may attend two meetings without paying. A non-member could attend two special events but would pay the non-member fee of \$5.00.

Goals for 2017 – Community Projects - Continue painting memory boxes, refurbish the mural wall at the County Hospital, and work on the lily pads for a children's hospital. It was suggested doing these on canvas bags as a Saturday program. Trish has not been able to connect with her contact at the Children's Hospital for the lily pads and Cathy will look into other pediatric hospitals. Ideas for projects to do at meetings will be requested.

New Members – Discussion followed on what we can do to attract and keep new members. It was suggested using some of our charity money to subsidize the SDP membership dues for one year only for a new member as an incentive to join. It was felt we need to re-educate people about what we are – not just tole painters, but

decorative painters. We could put a larger sign in our library displays.

Special Drawings – Merlene has the left-over Traditions paints from Jillybean’s class and it was agreed to hold a separate special drawing for the paints at the next meeting, in addition to the normal special drawing. These tickets will be sold for \$1.00 each.

2017 Budget – Jann reviewed the proposed budget item by item and will present the finalized budget to the members for approval. She noted she is waiting for expenses from Connie Oakley for Bunco and the anniversary party. She noted our SDP insurance cost is based on the number of our members.

NCCC – There will not be a retreat this year. The hotel is requesting a \$30,000 guarantee which is not doable. We do not have a representative for next year and NCCC is aware of that.
The meeting adjourned at 3:00 pm.

Please Note: Due to the 2017 Planning meeting held on Sunday, November 13, 2016, the Board meeting for November 15, 2016 was cancelled.

The meeting was called to order at 7:01 pm by Acting President Karen Vecchi with a quorum present. The minutes of the October meeting were approved as published in the November newsletter (Shirley Irwin/Sally Colclough).

New Members/Guests: Barbara Bouchet introduced her guest Debbie Trapp who is joining, D.J. West introduced her fiancé David Davis, and Jeannie Press was introduced who joined this evening. Per Karen, Janet McCarthy has sent in her membership.

Presentation of Charity Checks: Sister Ann was presented with a check for \$775 for the Bay Area Crisis Nursery. She described the program which provides short term respite care and crisis services for families. Jeanie Strech donated baby blankets and clothes to the program.

Spiderman Ricky Mena accepted a check for \$775 for the Heart of a Hero program. He described the origin of the program noting that he has visited children nationwide and parts of Canada. The program has a social media presence and pictures will be posted. Donations are used for toys and his travel expenses.

A check for \$300 was presented previously to First Lutheran Church for use of their facilities for our meetings.

Christmas Dinner: Karen reminded us the dinner is December 13 at Mangia Bene in Martinez and checks need to be sent to Cathy McCaughey by December 6. The cost is \$30 per person and beverages are extra.

First Lutheran Church Fundraisers: Darlene Smith thanked everyone for the many donations brought tonight for the December 10 Breakfast with Santa and the January, 2017 crab feed. Additional crab feed donations may be brought to the January TBT meeting.

Membership: Karen advised 25 members have renewed. National dues must be paid by November or will go up \$5. Discussion followed regarding the chapter paying the \$30 first time SDP membership dues for one year as an incentive to attract new members. Merlene Ryan felt this would encourage her class members to join. They would need to pay the \$15 TBT membership dues. It was noted the chapter meets three times a year on Saturday. **Luci Flynn moved that the chapter pay the SDP membership dues of \$30 for new members for the first year for 2017. Trish Bertolucci seconded the motion. The motion carried.**

Treasurer’s Report: Jann Otvos passed out the 2017 proposed budget and reviewed it. She noted all expenses for Bunco and the 20th Anniversary Party have not been received to date. There are no changes except the mileage expense to attend NCCC meetings has been deleted as we do not have representatives attending the meetings. **Trish Bertolucci moved we accept the 2017 budget. Barbara Bouchet seconded the motion. The motion carried.**

Ways and Means: Trish advised there are two special drawing prizes this evening. Vivian Roubal has donated a basket with several metal items and Merlene has the leftover Traditions paints from the Jillybean seminar. The basket tickets are \$3 each and the paint tickets are \$1 per ticket.

Hospitality: Barbara Bouchet will seek volunteers to bring beverages/ice/snacks to the January meeting.

Seminars: Merlene Ryan announced the Carolyn Silvas giraffe project of reverse painting on Plexiglas is Saturday, January 21, 2017 at the church location. The registration form is in the November newsletter and the fee covers all supplies and paint. She needs a final count by early January and the deposit.

Awards and Recognition: Shirley Irwin presented awards to Karen Vecchi (2), Merlene Ryan (2) and Marianne Simpson.

Community Service: Liz Little is still trying to contact the County Hospital regarding the wall mural.

Bunco: Karen announced Liz Little has reserved the Plumbers’ Hall for our August 26, 2017 Bunco fundraiser.

Christmas Party Ornament Exchange: Karen announced the ornaments are to be handmade and fit in a small lunch size brown paper bag. Lisa Schall commented that two years ago we donated toilet paper at the Christmas dinner for Battered Women. Last year we donated new, unwrapped toys for the Heart of a Hero program and she recommended we do the toy donations again this year. Please bring the new, unwrapped toys to the Christmas Dinner.

Announcements: Liz Doran brought a copy of the Brentwood News with an article about the "A Place of Learning" tutoring program, an inspirational program helped in the past by our donations

Jeanie Strech brought a basket of free cornucopias and some Bunco donations for next year.

TIPS, HINTS AND HELPS TRADING POST

This portion of the newsletter is to help out our fellow painters with hints, tips, shortcuts or whatever we can share to help each other become better painters! If you find something that helped you, send it to Trish Bertolucci at berts4@comcast.net and she will make sure it goes into the newsletter the following month! We can always use a little help.

We had some yummy snacks at our November meeting and quite a few members requested Liz Doran's Pumpkin Oat Pie Squares. Here is the recipe:

1 Cup Flour
 1/2 Cup Quick cooking oats
 1/2 Cup brown sugar
 1/2 cold butter cut into pieces
 1- 15 oz pureed pumpkin
 1- 12 oz can evaporated milk
 2 eggs
 3/4 cup sugar
 1/2 tsp salt
 1 tsp cinnamon
 1/4 tsp cloves
 1/2 chopped chopped pecans
 1/2 cup brown sugar
 2 TBS butter

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl, combine the flour, oats, brown sugar and butter. Rub between your fingers or use two forks to mix until crumbly. Press into an ungreased 9X13 pan and bake for 15 minutes.

While the crust is baking, prepare the filling. In a large bowl, combine the pumpkin, evaporated milk, eggs, sugar, salt, cinnamon and cloves. Beat until smooth and well blended. Pour over the baked crust. Bake at 350 for 20 minutes. During that time, make the topping by combining the pecans, brown sugar and butter in a bowl. Mix the topping using your hands until the topping resembles coarse crumbs. Sprinkle the topping over the pumpkin mixture and bake again for 15-20 minutes or until the filling is set. Let cool completely before cutting into squares.

The purpose of the society is a central dissemination point for information about activities related to decorating painting; raise and maintain a high standard for the art of decorative painting; and stimulate interest in and appreciation for the art form.
